Project Title: Benton Road Extension (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-RIV-30988-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): The Benton Road Extension Project (Project) is located within an unnamed tributary to the Santa Margarita River, between Benton Road and Auld Road, just west of Pourroy Road, in the French Valley area, County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.590272 Longitude -117.104291; Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 963-010-006. The Project is within Section 5, Township 7 South, Range 2 West and is included within the lands shown on the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) – Bachelor Mountain quadrangle, 7.5 Minute Series topographic map

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-RIV-30988-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Mike Byer of Richland Communities.

The Benton Road Extension Project includes the construction of two road crossings over the unnamed stream where the roads crossings will have a 36-inch and 48-inch reinforced concrete pipe along with ¼ ton riprap placed. Road crossings will consist of the installation of two sets of concrete headwalls, underground pipe, and outlet structures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on January 25, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
