### **Description of Project:**

The project consists of entitlement requests for a Use Permit and Special Development Permit to allow for auto wholesales and a parking reduction, on a 0.44-acre parcel in an urbanized area, located in a GC (General Commercial) zoning district. Used and new auto sales, are allowed in the GC zone, upon approval of the Conditional Use Permit. ## Reasons why project is exempt:

The project is exempt under Categorical Exemption, Class 1 (CEQA Guidelines Section 15301) because the project consists of the permitting and operation of a business within an existing facility resulting in negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing.
