The proposed project includes renaming and redeveloping the existing park. The project would change the name of the park from Columbus Park to Janet Gray Hayes Park and include demolition of all existing park facilities, recreational equipment and improvements, and construction of new lighted multi-sport playing fields and courts, restrooms, a picnic area and a maintenance building. The project would also reconfigure Irene, Asbury, and Walnut Streets as a one-directional perimeter access roads, construct a new parking lot on the eastern project boundary, temporarily close Spring Street between Asbury and West Taylor Street, and construct a new pedestrian paseo in its place. As a part of the park redevelopment, the park will be renamed.
