Project Description: Tentative Parcel Map No. 38373 proposes the subdivision of 31.39 net acres as a multifamily residential project. The project site is located generally northwest of Monroe Avenue (Sparkman Drive) and Murrieta Hot Springs Road. The proposed project includes 899 total units, which include 5% (45 units) proposed as affordable units (very low). Tentative Tract Map 38373 and Development Plan 2022-2518 proposes the subdivision into two (2) large development phases that include 11 residential buildings of four (4) stories each and 9 two-story carriage-style buildings. Phasing Plan 2022-2614 addresses one (1) mass grading phase of the entire site and two (2) development phases.
