The "Project" consists of expanding the existing Treana Winery at 4280 Second Windy Way in the City of Paso Robles. The proposed project would include approximately 225,000 square feet of additional production and storage space to the existing 132,440 square foot of winery operations facility. The proposed project includes the development of an additional 24,830 square feet of parking lot area and 98,860 square feet of other paved surfaces.

The project site is approximately 16.5 acres and is east of Second Wind Way, west of Wright Way, and north of Dry Creek Road. Construction of the proposed project is anticipated to begin in May 2023 and be completed by May 2024. Thus, the first full year of proposed project operations would be 2025. The proposed project would generate approximately 380 new vehicle trips per weekday (133 truck trips and 247 passenger car trips).

The Public Review Period for the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration will commence on Friday, February 10, 20232 and conclude on Tuesday, March 14, 2023.
