Interior improvements include: renovation of interior space for administrative offices, enclosure of the existing portico, addition of new entry shade structure at arrival, a new entry door at main lobby, addition of a new elevator, new public restrooms, a new lounge, a new kitchen, interior finish and cosmetic repair work, accessible restroom, and new accessible guest suites. Exterior improvements include: redesign of the courtyard, addition of a reflection pond, replacement of existing pathway to make it ADA accessible, enhancement of the building entry path, incorporation of a service pathway around the building, an accessible entrance to the existing pool, and renovation of the existing pool, etc.
