The current diversion includes a screened intake that hangs from a bridge and is lowered into the channel when diverting water. Two pumps sit on the channel bank that pump the diverted water approximately 100 vertical feet uphill to an injection well. The new diversion system will include a new screen installed on the creek bed, pumping facilities on the creek bank, and piping system designed to reduce impacts to multiple aquatic species and improve the overall safety and operations of the diversion.
