The Project will occur at Lake Solano Park (Park) which is located on the south bank of Putah Creek in Solano County approximately 4.5 miles southwest of the town of Winters. Most of the proposed Project work will be on 19 acres in the upland areas of the Park above the upper day use parking lot. Limited Project work (consisting solely of interpretive and way finding signage) will also occur in the riparian corridor of Putah Creek in the Park 's day use area. The purpose of the Project is to restore wildlife and native plant habitat, improve public access and recreational opportunities, and provide visitors with interpretive and educational materials. The Project proposes to plant up to 2,265 native trees, shrubs, and subshrubs, up to 20,000 native forb plugs, and up to 300 pounds of native grass and wildflower seed on 19 acres in the upland terraces located above the upper day use parking lot. Within this restored area, a half-acre native plant demonstration garden will be installed, including 670 feet of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible trail with two decomposed granite (DG) pads, and 10-15 plant identification signs. A simple shade structure with a gravel pad will be installed at the highest elevation of the Park and will provide an overlook point for Park visitors and elementary school students on field trips. Park signage will be improved in the upland areas of the Park above the upper day use parking lot and in the Park 's main day use area with the installation of 10-15 small wayfinding signs, 10-15 interpretive panels, and but before.
