**PROJECT TITLE:** Carnegie Town and Kiln Panels

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT:** The purpose of this project is to install new interpretive panels in the Kiln Canyon staging and Kiln Canyon Trail area at Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area to educate the public on the historic significance of the Carnegie Brick and Pottery Factory, Carnegie Town, and Lime Kiln. Work will:

- Use a gas auger to excavate eight (8) 8-inch diameter by 24-inch-deep holes;
- Place one (1) 80-inch tall by eight (8) inch wide metal post in each hole and backfill with concrete to secure;
- Attach the interpretive panels to the posts (two (2) posts per panel); and
- Spread excavated materials on site.
