## **Project Description:**

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Procession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved Cannabis Licenses submitted on 01/12/2022, by Gary Ortiz. Gary Ortiz applied for ten Small Mixed-Light Tier 1, one Processor, and one Nursery license on an existing agricultural operation.

#### **Project Activities:**

On APN: 218-0-091-170 the Project will consist of four 10,540 sq. ft. & six 12,180 sq. ft. greenhouses for mixed-light cultivation, one 10,540 sq. ft. greenhouse for drying and curing, one 10,540 sq. ft. greenhouse for production storage and distribution, two 10,540 sq. ft. greenhouses for the nursery. The proposed total cultivation canopy area on the parcel is 100,000 square feet. Water for irrigation is a water utility service and power is sourced from the grid. No site expansion is proposed other than tenant improvements to the existing structures. One storage shed will be demolished and access to the site will be via an existing culverted bridge with no bridge maintenance activities proposed.

On APN: 218-0-070-180 the Project will consist of six 12,600 sq. ft. greenhouses for mixed light cultivation with 59,400 sq. ft. of total cultivation canopy area. No site expansion is proposed other than tenant improvements to the existing structures, water is sourced from a retail water supplier, and power is sourced from the grid.
