requesting to accept waste tonnage beyond daily Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) limits until the end of	
the declared emergency and through June	26, 2023, at its Prima Deshecha Landfill (PDL) in San Juan
Capistrano. The maximum daily permitted tonnage will be temporarily increased at PDL from 4,000 tons/day	
to 6,000 tons/day. By allowing a temporary increase in additional daily tonnage at the County landfill OCWR
