NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

MUP20-0004 (Chris Ottone - North State Rendering)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Butte County has prepared an Initial Study (IS) and is considering the adoption of a Negative Declaration (ND) for the project listed below. The County has prepared this Notice of Intent to Adopt a ND to provide an opportunity for input from public agencies, organizations, and interested parties on the environmental analysis addressing the potential effects of the proposed project.

PROJECT TITLE: Minor Use Permit for Chris Ottone - North State Rendering (MUP20-0004).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is the existing North State Rendering, Inc. facility located at 15 Shippee Road, northeast of the intersection with State Highway 99. Assessor Parcel Number: 041-200-023.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Minor Use Permit in connection with a current use permit (UP10-0004) to include and allow sewer septage to be processed by North State Rendering, Inc. (NSR) within its existing anaerobic digester. The NSR facility consists of a former rendering facility, bio-digester and pond system. The proposed project would allow the processing of septic waste that would otherwise be disposed at a disposal facility outside the county. A pilot study conducted by NSR determined that the bio-digester can process a mixture of food and septic waste and produce both useable bio-gas and an effluent stream that is acceptable for disposal into the existing process wastewater ponds. Approval of MUP20-0004 would allow the delivery and unloading of septage waste by septic haulers into the existing bio-digester concrete pit. It would be blended with the existing food waste and sent to the bio-digester system. The project would not change the overall operation, require any additional infrastructure, or expand the capacity of the facility. The septage material would replace a portion of the food waste and offer an alternative to landfill disposal as a method of processing. Solid waste from the screening process would continue to be stored in dumpsters for landfill disposal.

The IS/ND is on file for public review and comment starting April 3, 2023, through May 2, 2023. All comments on the IS/ND must be submitted in writing to the address or email provided below and received no later than 5:00 pm, Tuesday, May 2, 2023.
