## PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Project Name: 70-80 North 27th Street Residential Project

**Description:** The proposed project is an application for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to demolish a partially occupied 21,454 square feet two -story retail commercial building and construct a new residential building consisting of five floors of residential units (198 in total) over common open space and vehicle parking for a total building height of 87 feet (including architectural features , such as parapets, turrets, and spires).

The City has performed an environmental review of the project. The project site is not present on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.

The public comment period for this Draft MND begins on **Friday**, **April 7**, **2023** and ends on **Thursday**, **April 27**, **2023**.
