San Bernardino County (County) proposes to consolidate its emergency communication services by developing a three-story 75,062 SF office building within approximately 6.49 gross acres of vacant land owned by the County and located on the southeast corner of S Lena Road and E Rialto Avenue in the City of San Bernardino (Project). The facility will serve as a consolidated communications and operations center to be occupied by the communications teams of various San Bernardino County emergency services departments including Sherriff's Department Communications Center (SBSD), Office of Emergency Services (OES), CONFIRE (consolidated City-County fire communications), Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency (ICEMA), Information Services Department (ISD)and Building Services, which currently have office locations throughout San Bernardino County. The Proposed Project is designed to replace the County's current communications center located at the Rialto Airport, with this location.
