Description of Activity		Due to Cross Valley Canal capacity limitations and to provide irrigation flexibility, Kern-Tulare Water District (KTWD) and Kern County Water Agency (KCWA) will conduct a bona fide water exchange through two water conveyances: (1) conveyance of up to 53,300 acre-feet of KCWA's 2023/2024 State Water Project (SWP) Table A water through KCWA's existing turnouts to KTWD, and (2) conveyance of a like amount of 2023 Central Valley Project (CVP) water supplies to KCWA where the United States Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) will make KTWD's CVP water available to DWR at Banks Pumping Plant and/or O'Neill Forebay for DWR to deliver to KCWA.
