PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Site Approval application for a hotel. This project will include a 3-story; 38,595-square-foot building, and a 575 square foot storage shed. The project site lies within the service boundary of CSA-31 for water, sewer, and storm drainage. This parcel is not under a Williamson Act Contract.

The Property is zoned C-FS (Freeway Service Commercial) and the General Plan designation is C/FS (Freeway Service Commercial).
