Project Title: Interstitial Systems (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 211 Fern St., Santa Cruz, CA 95062 within the City of Santa Cruz.

County: Santa Cruz

Project Description:

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Procession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Cannabis License submitted on 5/12/2020 by Jeffery Walker and John Heekin (licensees). The licensees applied for a cannabis distribution license and a Type 7 cannabis manufacturing license.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of a Level 2 volatile cannabis manufacturing use that includes manufacturing, distribution, and transportation of raw and finished products. The site is located in the I-G zone district and is developed with an approximately 3,600 square foot commercial building. The previous use was an automotive use and the building is currently vacant. The applicant is not proposing any exterior alterations, with all work taking place inside the existing 3,600 square foot building. The interior space will be divided up into two 120 square foot prefabricated extraction rooms, 454 square foot packing area, 800 square foot post-processing area, 670 square foot distillation area, 46 square feet of locked storage cabinets, 424 square foot incoming material area and a 120 square foot pre-fab walk in freezer. The existing restroom, breakroom, lobby, and office will remain in the same location. The manufacturing use will produce three categories of cannabis products: extracted cannabis in the form of wax, distilled cannabis oil for vaporized cartridges and other various forms of isolated cannabis molecules for research and development.
