Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Activity / Project: The Project consists of extending the water mains from the Cal Water Visalia Service to Harrison Road and Avenue 266 to connect approximately 25 homes with dry wells. The Project includes installing approximately 1,290 feet of an 8-inch Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) water main, approximately 1,820 feet of a 12-inch Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP) water main, approximately 27 metered service connections (main to meters), and two fire hydrants. The community is currently relying on hauled water or water from neighboring properties. The Project will provide a sustainable source of water for the residences along Harrison Road and Avenue 266 during drought conditions and also provides a reliable/safe drinking source for its residents. This project is supported by California Water Service Company (Cal Water).
