

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration and Notice of Availability of the Draft Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and Draft Evaluation of Potential Section 4(f) Resources and *De Minimis* Impact Determination for the Sonoma State Route 1

Drainage System Restoration Project.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Lead Agency for the California Environmental Quality Act, is issuing a Notice of Intent to adopt a Negative Declaration and a Notice of Availability for the Draft Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND) and Draft Evaluation of Potential Section 4(f) Resources and *De Minimis* Impact Determination for public and agency review.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

Caltrans proposes to replace culverts at 15 locations between post miles 0.97 and 28.73 on SR 1 in Sonoma County for the Sonoma State Route 1 (SR 1) Drainage System Restoration Project (Project). The Project would also include improving drainage at two additional locations, installing rock slope protection, flared end sections, and drainage inlets, as well as constructing concrete headwalls and excavating and regrading slopes and ditches. Replacing aging and degrading culverts would restore drainage flow and prevent culvert failure.

WHY THIS AD?

Caltrans has studied the proposed Project and has determined that there would not be any significant impacts to environmental resources as a result of the Project. The Draft IS/ND and Draft Evaluation of Potential Section 4(f) Resources and *De Minimis* Impact Determination explain why the Project would not have significant impacts to environmental resources or adverse effects on Section 4(f) resources. This public notice is to inform you that the Draft IS/ND and Draft Evaluation of Potential Section 4(f) Resources and *De Minimis* Impact Determination are available for review during the 30-day public comment period.
