DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project proposes to re-establish the archaeological integrity of the exposed archeological exhibit located approximately in the middle of the Casa de Reyes dining area, by preventing further damage to historic fabric, including properly documenting what remains of this feature. The process consists of removing plants and debris, photo documentation, measurements, and a to-scale detailed drawing of the feature. Once documented, geotextile will be placed over the feature, which will then be covered with approximately 6 inches of sand before it is capped. The protected feature will be leveled to match the surrounding flooring material.
