Approval of a Minor Use Permit to allow for the development to construct a 2,200 square foot gas station/convenience store on 0.45 acres (19,365 sq.ft).. The project would construct a gas station with 6 fueling positions located under a canopy and a convenience store on a vacant parcel in the Community of Bloomington, County of San Bernardino. The existing vacant parcel is described as Assessor<sup>2</sup> s Parcel No. (APN) 0253-201-18. The convenience store would be 2,200 square feet (sf).
