**LOCATION:** Railtown 1897 State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Tuolumne

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: This project proposes to construct a new structure at Railtown 1897 State Historic Park to provide a covered environment with secondary containment for the protection of waste oil drums and new oil drums that are sitting outside, uncovered and exposed to the weather. Between the Tri-Dam building and the Compressor Shed, 6-ft back from the nearest track, and 60-ft from the corner of the Tri Dam building at the site of an old shed removed back in 2006, work will:

- Remove existing overburden and excavate a 12-ft deep x 24-ft long area for the proposed shed;
- Excavate a 12-in. x 12-in. x 64 foot long French drain behind the proposed shed site and behind the existing compressor shed and tie into an existing drain on the western side of the compressor shed;
- Install a 4-in. drainpipe, laid in a bed of \(^3\)-in. to 1 \(^1\)-in. crushed rock, to carry water to the drain;
- Install a bed of sand (after the loose topsoil/debris has been removed) and pour a 5-in. thick concrete pad (with a 3-in. slope in the floor for the first 3-ft in and out of the shed to act as secondary containment capable of holding approximately 500 gallons of any spilled product meeting the code of 10% storage) at the shed site;
- Install four (4) 6-in. x 6-in. x 12-ft tall corner posts and a 24-foot glue lam beam to span across the proposed open front;
- Install corrugated panels to enclose the sides, back and cover the roof; and
- Install a clean-out box at the north end to allow hydro-jetting of drain to clear any build-up.
