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## **Project Description:**

The proposed project consists of the following:

- <u>Lakeshore Blvd Water Main Replacement:</u> The replacement of the existing water line with new 8inch PVC pipe from the vicinity of Ashe St. to Beach Lane. The total footage is 2,866 feet and includes 23 services.
- Fairview Drive Water Main Replacement: The replacement of the existing water line with new 8inch PVC pipe from Green Street to Hillcrest for a total footage of 1,386 feet and includes 30 services.
- 3. <u>Tenth Street Water Main Replacement:</u> The replacement of the existing water line with new 8-inch PVC pipe on 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Brush Street to Tunis Street and on Tunis Street from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 11th Street for a total footage of 500 feet and includes 3 services.
- Armstrong Street Water Main Replacement: The replacement of the existing water line with new 8inch PVC pipe on Armstrong St. from Berry St. to 207' feet West of Smith St. for a total footage of 983 feet and includes 6 services.
- Martin Street Water Main Replacement: The replacement of the existing water line with new 10inch PVC pipe on Martin St. from Bevins St. to S. Main St. for a total footage of 2,560 feet and includes 28 services.
- Martin Street Sewer Main Replacement: The replacement of the existing sewer line with new 10inch PVC pipe on Martin St. from Bevins St. to S. Main St. for a total footage of 2,560 feet and includes 27 laterals.
- 7. <u>Lakeport Blvd Water Main Replacement:</u> The replacement of the existing water line with new 10-inch PVC pipe on Lakeport Blvd from Bevins St. to S. Main St. for a total footage of 2,126 feet and includes 18 services.
- Lakeport Blvd Sewer Main Replacement: The replacement of the existing sewer line with new 10inch PVC pipe on Martin St. from Bevins to S. Main St. for a total footage of 2,560 feet and includes 27 laterals
- 9. <u>K Street Sewer Main Installation:</u> The installation of approximately 200' feet of 8-inch sewer main from Lakeport Blvd Lift Station to an existing manhole.

## **Reason Why Project is Exempt:**

Class 1 includes the repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, involving negligible or no expansion of use; Class 2 includes replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity; and Class 4 includes minor alterations in the condition of land that do not involve removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees, including minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored.

The Project is consistent with the categorical exemptions noted above because work would consist of repair, replacement, maintenance, and minor alterations to existing facilities; negligible expansion of capacity or use would occur; the majority of the pipelines would be placed in previously disturbed areas within the public road ROW and in public utility easements; and the ground surface would be restored following construction.
