The project includes the update to the City's 6th Cycle Housing Element Update (2023-2031) Housing and Community Development (HCD) Revised Draft (dated January 24, 2024) ("Housing Element Update") and the update to the City's Safety Element. The adoption of these two elements would be an amendment to the City's General Plan/Coastal Land Use Program (General Plan). It is not expected that the updates to the City's Safety Element result in any physical changes. The Housing Element Update includes 410 housing units, which is approximately 17 percent more than the RHNA of 349 units. The City does not anticipate that future housing projects proposed on sites with existing commercial/office uses would also result in expanded building square footage for such uses.
