PROJECT DESCRIPTION: To provide a safe pedestrian access, a new 4-feet wide trail, approximately 800 feet long along the base of the undeveloped hillside on the south side of Garin Avenue in Hayward. Construction of the trail will include the use of a small tractor (or equivalent) to cut a shallow bench in portions of the trail on steeper slopes and only minor grading in flatter areas. The trail will be graveled and may include the trimming of one small coast live oak tree (Quercus agrifolia). Trail access will be from an existing access gate at the intersection with Bello Road and a new access gate will be provided approximately 200 feet to the east of that location. The public currently walks along the roadway to enter the main entrance of the park, which is a public safety concern. The trail will provide safe pedestrian access into the park, separated from the roadway along the same path of travel. Tree trimming of one small oak tree may be needed to provide clear line of site for pedestrians and vehicles. Additionally, Standard Park District Best Management Practices will be implemented as part of the project.

The trail alignment is located along the base of a hillside dominated by non-native grasses and weedy herbaceous species. There are no wetlands, streams, or ponds on or bordering the project site. The potential for specialstatus species to occur on or bordering the project site is considered very low due to the fact that the area is dominated by weedy vegetation characteristic of disturbed areas and there is no Alameda whipsnake core habitat (scrub/chaparral habitat) on or bordering the project site and there are no know California tiger salamander populations within Garin Regional Park.

DETERMINATION: The Park District has reviewed the proposed project and determined it to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under the following sections of Article 19, Categorical Exemptions, of the State CEQA Guidelines in the California Administrative Code:

Board of Directors

Section 15301(c) – Existing Facilities. The proposed project meets the requirements of a Class I Categorical Exemption in the CEQA Guidelines, "consists of an existing street, sidewalk, bicycle and pedestrian trail" which includes "grading for the purpose of public safety". The trail will provide safe pedestrian access into the park, separated from the roadway along the same path of travel into the main entrance of Garin Regional Park.

Section 15304 – Minor Alterations to Land. The proposed project meets the requirements of a Class 4 Categorial Exemption – Minor Alterations to Land which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. The trail will be graveled, which involve minor alterations in the condition of land and vegetation and may include the trimming of one small coast live oak tree.
