PLYMOUTH ROAD AND MISSION ROAD SIDEWALK REPAIR Project Description

Project Location:

Plymouth Road and Mission Road. See attached Vicinity Map.

Project Justification:

The Sidewalk Repair Program was first established and implemented in 2003. This annual program addresses the need to repair sections of existing curbs, gutters and sidewalks that are either broken or displaced to such an extent that it creates a safe hazard. With the additional availability of funds, in addition to the Sidewalk Repair Program, this project will help to address additional concerns. This program will be processed through Job Order Contracts (JOC).

Existing curbs and gutter with no sidewalks and curb ramps forces pedestrians to walk along uneven terrain, with difficult limited-mobility pedestrian access at intersections. Residents of this low income/disadvantaged community have made requests to the County for a safe walking infrastructure to provide access to surrounding community services.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

Removing and replacing identified segments of existing curb, gutter and sidewalk. The
existing curbs, gutters and sidewalks will be saw-cut and removed. The new curbs, gutters
and sidewalks will be installed to match. The work involves the removal and replacement of
12,214 square feet of curbs, gutters and sidewalks at approximately 46 separate locations
throughout county areas in Road Districts 1.


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **residential with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety for walking within the project limits, as there will be new sidewalks in place.




VICINITY MAP


